Adjectives Ending in "er"

There are some adjectives in the First/Second Declensions whose masculine nominative form ends in "er."

Which part of the dictionary entry for adjectives is this? \_\_\_\_\_

For these adjectives, it is **VERY** important that you use the **FEMININE** form to find your base.

If you use the masculine form, you might form the word incorrectly.

For **ALL** adjectives, use the **FEMININE** form to find your base. (2<sup>nd</sup> word in Dictionary Entry)

1. liber, libera, liberum: free
2. pulcher, pulchra, pulchrum: beautiful
3. noster, nostra, nostrum: our
